**NOTICE OF PROPOSED CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT**

TO: All persons and entities with Illinois fax numbers who (1) in the period between November 1, 2004, and January 1, 2009, (2) were sent faxes by or on behalf of Rick Levin & Associates, Inc., promoting or advertising its goods or services, (3) and who did not provide express permission or consent to RLA to send facsimiles.

This Summary Notice is to inform you of the proposed Settlement of a class action lawsuit having to do with unsolicited fax advertising. Your fax number has been identified as one which may have been sent the unsolicited advertisements at issue in this lawsuit. The defendant denies liability, but the parties have agreed to a proposed Settlement. If you are a member of the Settlement Class, you may be entitled to payment of up to \$375, if this Settlement is approved by the Court and if you properly submit a claim form **by March 30, 2012**. According to the proposed Settlement, the Defendant shall make available up to a total of \$600,000, which will be reduced by attorney fees and costs awarded by the Court, not to exceed \$200,000 and an incentive award to Plaintiff James Iverson for having acted as class representative, not to exceed \$6,400.00. The amount remaining in the fund, less costs related to notice and administration, will be used to pay up to \$375 per valid claim. The payment amount may be reduced on a pro rata basis among those submitting timely, valid claim forms if the number of claims submitted is such that the settlement funds are not enough to pay each valid claim \$375.. The parties believe that there are between 400- 4,000 class members.

If you want to be excluded from the Settlement or if you wish to object to the Settlement, you must comply with the instructions and requirements set forth in the complete Notice of Pendency of Class Action and Proposed Settlement. If you choose to make a claim, you must fill out the claim form below completely and submit it **by March 30, 2012**.
